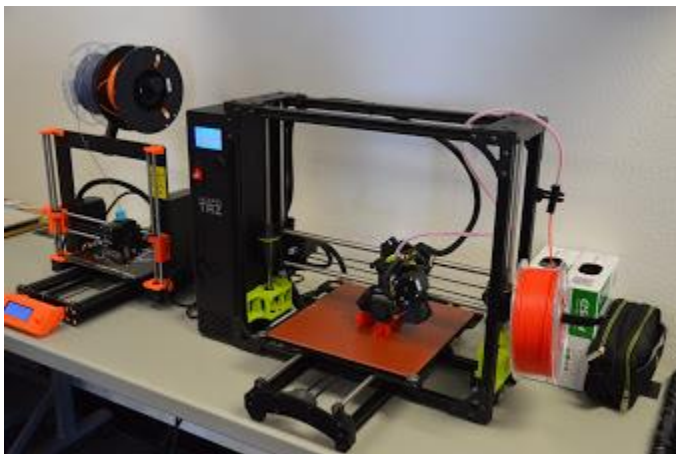
Winterfest 2019

Tech Ed Makerspace

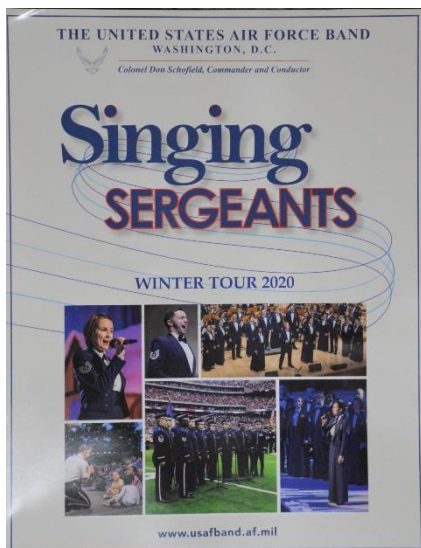
